VP for Cattle Procurement at JBS, Larry Rose, from Greely, Colorado, will give an overview of JBS, including information on a feedlot leased by JBS in Nicholasville, NY, marketing dairy beef and risk management in regard to raising beef.

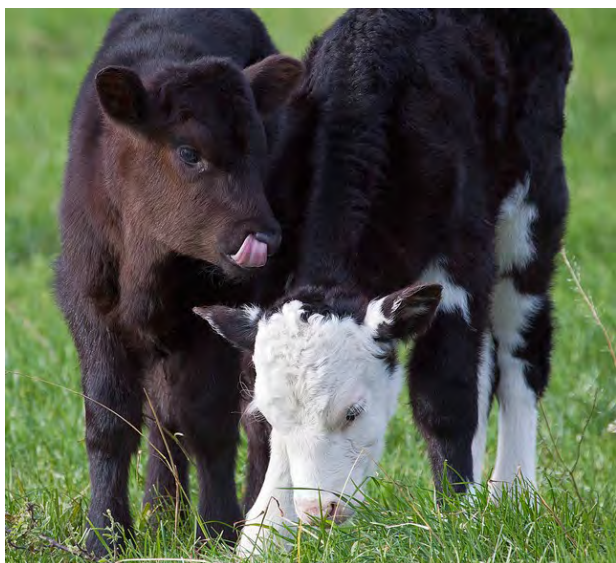
