

GUEST SPEAKER BIOS:

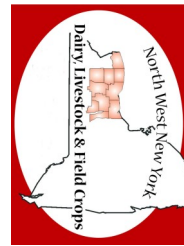
Dr. Mark M. Loux is a Professor and Extension Specialist in weed science in the Department of Horticulture and Crop Science at The Ohio State University. Dr. Loux received his B.S. in Plant Science from the University of Delaware in 1981, and his M.S. and Ph.D. in Agronomy from the University of Illinois in 1985 and 1988, respectively. Dr. Loux is responsible for weed science research and extension programs in soybeans, corn, wheat, and forages in Ohio. His research program at OSU focuses on herbicide resistance and management of weeds in reduced-tillage systems. Dr. Loux developed and is currently a co-author of the "Weed Control Guide for Ohio, Indiana, and Illinois", and is an active contributor to the C.O.R.N. newsletter (corn.osu.edu), a primary information delivery tool for the OSU Agronomic Crops Team.



Mike Staton is a Senior Soybean Educator with Michigan State University Extension. He received his BS and MS degrees from Michigan State University and has worked as an Extension educator for the past 30 years. His position is jointly funded by MSU Extension and the Michigan soybean checkoff. Mike leads the soybean on-farm research program and other soybean-related agronomic educational activities conducted by MSU Extension field staff in Michigan.
