Beef producers are invited to attend a classroom session and chute-side workshop on Thursday, September 5th, 2019 at 6 p.m. starting at CCE Schoharie County. Ashley McFarland, CNYDLFC Livestock Specialist, will discuss vaccinations and health management in beef cattle. The chute-side workshop will offer demonstration and practice of proper sub-cutaneous injections. Participants will become eligible for "BQA" certification.
