Sampling Details:

Farmers in the local area are encouraged to cut a bundle of 3 stalks from each corn field that they would like to be tested for dry matter, and bring them to the mill from 10am – 2pm. Sample corn stalks should be from a representative area in the field, and should be cut the morning of **September 6th** at the height you plan to set your chopper. If you are unable to bring your stalks to the mill during the dry down time frame, please reach out to the contacts below to make a plan to get your samples picked up.
