### **The Endemic Calf Parasite *Cryptosporidium Parvum* - PSU Extension**

*Cryptosporidium parvum* (Crypto) is the leading cause of diarrhea in neonatal calves 7 to 21 days of age and causes watery diarrhea, dehydration, and poor nutrient absorption in calves. It is most problematic since it is present in most farms. [In this article](#), you can learn more about management strategies to control this pathogen on your farm.
