Milk Loss Assistance Offered for 2020, 2021, and 2022 Disaster Events Farms that had to dump milk, without coop compensation, due to qualifying weather events are eligible to signup through FSA to receive 75-90% of their milk's value. Additionally, Erie County farms (all commodities) that were affected by the November 2022 storm are eligible to apply for relief funding of up to \$200,000 through the ECSWCD.
