### **Deer Worm Season is Nearly Upon Us – Are you Prepared?**

Deer worm is a parasitic worm of sheep and goats that affects the nervous system and tends to rear its ugly head as we head into fall. The parasite lives part of its lifecycle in snails, slugs, and white-tailed deer, so if you have these on your property, you can be at risk. Cornell has developed a treatment protocol to use as an option for infected animals, which can be found in [this factsheet](#).
