### **Allegany, Cattaraugus, and Steuben Counties Receive Disaster Declaration**

Farms affected by Tropical Storm Debby from August 8<sup>th</sup> to August 10<sup>th</sup>, 2024 are now eligible to apply for emergency credit through the Farm Service Agency. Emergency loans can provide capital for replacement equipment, livestock, structures, or even debt refinancing. Farms should call their county USDA office for more information.
