Dewormer Drug Classes for Small Ruminant Parasites

Deworming is something all small ruminant producers need to do, but with so many trade names on the market, it's sometimes a surprise to realize that there are only three classes of active ingredients. Using an active ingredient that works on your farm can help overcome parasite challenges, and knowing which trade name falls into which class can help you make smart purchasing decisions.
